

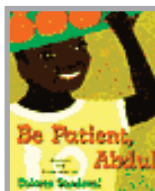


the possibilities are endless...

- Bake sales & candy sales, with proceeds benefiting the children of All As One.

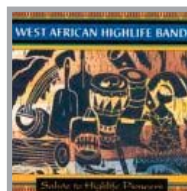
